### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008*.
- 1.2. Royal Yachting Association (RYA) prescriptions relating to rules 68, 70.4, 86.3, 87 and App F and to ISAF Regulation 20 will apply and will be stated in full in the sailing instructions.
- 1.3. Racing rules 28.1, 35, 44.1, 44.2, 61.3, 62.1, 62.2, A2 and A4.1 will be changed by the sailing instructions in which the changes will appear in full.
- 1.4. The ISAF Offshore Special Regulations for Category 4 shall apply to boats in Classes Q, 0, 1, 2 and 3 except that any boats that do not fully comply with the Regulations may apply to the Organising Authority for written dispensation. (The Special Regulations are available on [www.sailing.org](http://www.sailing.org)).
- 1.5. There shall be a minimum of two entries in a Class for the Class to race.

### 2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. Advertising - ISAF Regulation 20.3.1 (b) Category C shall apply.
- 2.2. Where provided by the Organising Authority, and where practicable, boats shall display a Brewin Dolphin sticker on the port bow throughout the event.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. The event is open to boats of the following classes:

- Class Q - Quarter Ton – IRC rating<sup>1</sup>
- Class 0 - Sportsboat with an IRC rating
- Classes 1 and 2 - Cruiser/racer - IRC rating<sup>2</sup>
- Class 3 – Cruiser/racer - Jersey Handicap<sup>3</sup>
- Class 4 - Dayboat (including small traditional open boats) – Jersey Handicap<sup>3</sup>
- Class 5 - Sport-catamaran - ISAF International Small Catamaran Handicap equal to or less than 1.29
- Class 6 - Sport-catamaran - ISAF International Small Catamaran Handicap more than 1.29
- Class 7 - Open dinghy - Portsmouth Yardstick Handicap equal to or less than 1170
- Class 8 - Open dinghy - Portsmouth Yardstick Handicap more than 1170

Notes:

- 1 Quarter Ton Class – to qualify as a Quarter Ton boat a boat shall have had an IOR rating of 18.5 or less during the period 1970 to 1996. In the case of series production boats only one of the series need have had a rating of 18.5 or less. (Ref. RORC).
  - 2 Classes 1 and 2 shall comprise cruiser/racer boats with an IRC rating. The Organising Authority will determine the handicap bands that shall form Classes 1 and 2 on the basis of the range of handicaps of entries received by the normal entry cut-off date.
  - 3 Classes 3 and 4 - A Jersey Handicap may be obtained free-of-charge by completing the accompanying application form and returning it with the entry form and fee to the Regatta Office. In the absence of an IRC rating or Jersey Handicap, the Organising Authority may allocate a Jersey Handicap to a boat for this event only.
  - 4 Class flags – each boat in Classes Q, 0, 1, 2 and 3 shall be responsible for providing its own class flag which shall be flown from the back-stay whilst racing. Class flags are Code Flag Q and numeral pennants 0, 1, 2 and 3 respectively.
- 3.2. Eligible boats shall enter by completing the attached entry form and sending it together with the required fee to the Regatta Office, to arrive by 2200 hours on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> August 2008. A late entry fee shall apply as indicated in NoR4.3 below.
- 3.3. The classification of entries will be posted on the St Helier YC and RCIYC notice boards by 2200 hours, Thursday, 28<sup>th</sup> August 2008. Any late entries will be added to the appropriate classes at the Organising Authority's discretion.

### 4. FEES

4.1. Fees are as follows:

4.1.1. For Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> September:

Classes Q, 0, 1, 2 and 3 - £15.00 per day

Classes 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 - £10.00 per day except where a boat is entirely crewed by persons aged 16 years and under on 7<sup>th</sup> September 2008, in which case the daily fee will be £6.00 per boat.

**Note: There is no fee for Friday 5<sup>th</sup> September.**

- 4.2. Fees include race entry, attendance at the Thursday and Friday evening receptions and the Sunday prize-giving buffet. Fees will not be refunded except at the Organising Authority's discretion.
- 4.3. A Late Entry Fee, equal to double the normal daily entry fee, shall apply to entries received after 2200 hours, Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> August 2008. This facility will close at 1300 hours, Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2008 after which no further entries will be accepted.
- 4.4. Other fees: Regatta Party tickets (for Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> September) – Adults £12.50 each; junior competitors (those aged 16 years and under on 7<sup>th</sup> September 2008) £10.00 each.
- 4.5. Berthing – there are no berthing fees during the event, see NoR 11 below.
- 4.6. Craneage – for the Quarter Ton Class, fees include the provision of craning in and out at the La Collette Marina at prescribed times prior to the first race and after the last race of the Regatta. Other craneage is not included and will be subject to prevailing commercial charges.

## 5. SCHEDULE – (See Schedules 1.1 and 1.2, attached)

### 5.1. Friday 5<sup>th</sup> September

#### 5.1.1. Morning programme - Classes Q, 0, 1, 2 and 3

5.1.1.1. Round-the-Island race, starting in St Aubin's Bay. The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 0825 hours,

**or**

5.1.1.2. A series of three races may be run back-to-back over Olympic-type courses in St Aubin's Bay or to the south of the Island for any or all classes. In this case, the scheduled time of the first warning signal will be 0925 hours.

The Race Committee will notify boats of its choice between the Round-the-Island race and Olympic course racing by means of an amendment published no later than 2000 hours on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> September 2008.

5.1.2. Evening programme – one race for Classes 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8. The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1755 hours.

5.2. Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> September - racing for all classes. The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 0925 hours on both days.

5.3. Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> September – save for the requirements of any general recall, no warning signal shall be made after 1500 hours and races not started by this time shall be abandoned.

## 6. MEASUREMENTS

6.1. Boats in Classes Q, 0, 1 and 2 shall deliver a current IRC rating certificate to the Regatta Office either prior to or with their entry form.

6.2. Boats in Classes 3 and 4 shall be in possession of a current Jersey Handicap, otherwise they shall submit an application for a Jersey Handicap with the entry form.

6.3. Boats in Classes 5 to 8 – boats shall conform to their 'as built' specification except that where a boat has been modified the Organising Authority may allocate it a revised handicap for this event only. It is the responsibility of any boat to declare any modifications to the Organising Authority.

## 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available from the Regatta Office from Monday 21<sup>st</sup> July 2008 on delivery of a completed entry form with the appropriate entry fee.

## 8. THE COURSES

8.1. **Classes Q, 0, 1, 2 and 3 – Friday** – the Round-the-Island race will start in St Aubin's Bay and follow an anticlockwise course around the Island, finishing on the St Helier YC line in the approaches to St Helier Harbour. The course area will be contained entirely within Admiralty chart 3655 (SCF5604.9). **Where the race committee decides to use Olympic-type courses, (see NoR 5.1.1.2 above), the provisions of NoR 8.2 (below) shall apply.**

8.2. **Classes Q, 0, 1, 2 and 3 – Saturday and Sunday** – courses will be set within St Aubin's Bay and/or to the south of the Island and use fixed marks, laid marks or a combination of both. The course area will be contained entirely within Admiralty chart 1137 (SCF5604.10).

8.3. **Classes 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 – Friday evening, Saturday and Sunday** - courses will be set within St Aubin's Bay and use laid marks. The course area will be contained entirely within Admiralty chart 1137 (SCF5604.10).

8.4. Full course details will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

## 9. PENALTY SYSTEM

For Classes 5 and 6, rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed in that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

## **10. SCORING**

10.1. The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.

10.2. For the purpose of determining the 'Brewin Dolphin Jersey Regatta - Best in Class' winner in each class, all races shall count towards a series for each class. One discard will be allowed, otherwise a boat's series score shall be the aggregate of its individual race scores over the entire event.

## **11. BERTHING**

11.1. Jersey Harbours will provide complimentary berthing for competing boats on the holding pontoon in the La Collette Marina from Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> September to Monday 8<sup>th</sup> September 2008, inclusive.

11.2. Visiting boats wishing to arrive earlier than Thursday should contact the Regatta Office in order to avail themselves of further concessionary berthing (e.g. free berthing from the preceding weekend).

## **12. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS**

Boats in Classes Q, 0, 1, 2, 3 and 4 shall not be hauled out during the event except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee. (Hauling out includes the use of legs and cradle berths that might otherwise be used over a low tide).

## **13. RADIO COMMUNICATION**

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions whilst racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## **14. PRIZES – Prizes will be awarded in each class as follows:**

14.1. Perpetual trophies as indicated in the Race Programme (Schedule 1).

14.2. Place prizes:

2 boats - first prize

3 boats – first and second prizes

4 or more boats – first, second and third prizes

14.3. Brewin Dolphin Jersey Regatta – Best in Class prizes will be awarded to the boats with the lowest aggregate scores in their classes over the three days, the single discard having been allowed.

14.4. Additional prizes may be awarded at the Organising Authority's discretion.

14.5. The Prize-giving will take place in St Helier YC as soon as possible after 1845 hours on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> September.

## **15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

15.1. A boat is entirely responsible for her own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race, Sailing Instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility.

15.2. Nothing done by the Organising Authority can reduce the responsibility of the boat nor will it make the Organising Authority responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred as a result of the boat taking part in the event. The Organising Authority encompasses everyone helping to run the racing and the event, and include the Organising Authority, the race committee, the race officers, patrol boats, beach-masters and other authorised helpers.

15.3. Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk, see rule 4 'Decision to Race'. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

## **16. INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000, including racing, throughout the event.
