You, your crew and partners are cordially invited to the welcoming reception and briefing for the 10th combined RCIYC, St Helier YC and St Catherine's SC **JERSEY REGATTA**, being held from **1830 to 2030 hours, Thursday 4th September in the RCIYC, St Aubin**. Your Brewin Dolphin Jersey Regatta polo shirts will be issued that evening.

The racing programme will open on the Friday morning with a Round-the-Island Race for the Sportsboat, Quarter Ton and Cruiser/racer classes with the warning signal scheduled for 0825 hours. Should the weather prove unsuitable for some or all classes, boats will race in St Aubin's Bay or to the south of the Bay.

The programme for dayboats, sport catamarans and dinghies is scheduled to start at 1800 hours that evening (half-an-hour earlier than in previous years). There will be a Commodore's Reception in St Helier YC at 1915 hours to which you, your crew and partners are invited and supper (payable) will be available in both the RCIYC and St Helier YC. Please remember to book with the clubs' stewards.

You will, also, need to reserve tickets for Saturday's Regatta Party. Numbers are limited and tickets will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis.

Jersey Harbours is, again, very kindly providing complimentary berthing for competitors in the La Collette Marina for the week of the Regatta. Please berth only in the designated area (alongside the western-most pontoon).
