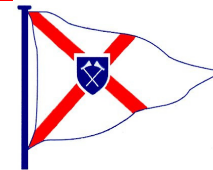
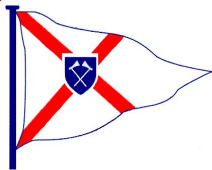

NOTICE OF RACE

Organising Authority: St Helier Yacht Club (SHYC)

1. RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the Rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012*.
- 1.2 The Prescriptions of the Royal Yachting Association will apply.
- 1.3 The ISAF Offshore Special Regulations for Monohulls and Multihulls Category 4 will apply.
- 1.4 Racing Rules 35, 61.3, 62.1, 62.2 and A4.1 will be changed. These changes will be shown in full in the Sailing Instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other rules.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. ISAF Regulation 20.3.1 (b) Category C shall apply.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The event is open to all boats which shall be racing in one single Class under a special handicap (The Coastal Series 2010 Rating) allocated by the Sailing Committee of the Organising Authority. The special handicap thus allocated shall not be subject to challenge.
- 3.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it so as be received at SHYC by no later than 18:00 GMT on Thursday 11th March 2010. A list of entrants and handicaps will be published by 18:00 GMT on Friday 12th March 2010.
- 3.3. Late entries may be accepted at the sole discretion of the Organising Authority. A boat may enter for any race of the Series, provided the entry form is received by 18:00 local time on the Thursday before that race in order that a handicap can be determined.
- 3.4. The following restrictions on the number of boats apply:
 - 3.4.1 There shall be a minimum of 2 boats starting to constitute any race in the series.

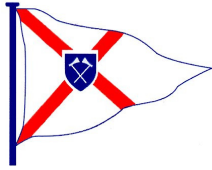
4. SCHEDULE

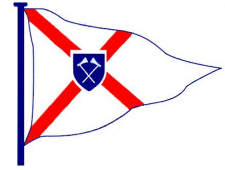
- 4.1 Races 3 and 5 may also be sailed for the Crews' and Ladies' trophies respectively. The boat's score will count towards the overall Coastal Series, regardless of whether the Crews' or Ladies' races are entered.
- 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**
- 5.1. Sailing Instructions will be available from SHYC from no later than 18:00 GMT on Wednesday 10th March 2010 on presentation of a completed entry form, and will be downloadable from www.shyc.je from the same date.
- 6. THE COURSE – To be described in full in the Sailing Instructions**
- 6.1. Courses will be set within the area of the south coast of the Island of Jersey and adjacent waters, as indicated by a hymn board on the starter boat, and may include one or more fixed marks as shown in the Sailing Instructions.
- 7. SCORING**
- 7.1. The Low Points System of scoring (A4.1) in Appendix A to *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012*, will apply.
- 7.2. Four races are required to be completed to constitute the series.
- 7.3. A boat must start in at least three races to be counted in the series.
- 7.4. A boat's series score will be the total of her best four race scores.
- 8. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS**
- 8.1 A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones and similar handheld devices.
- 8.2 Boats should maintain a listening watch on VHF channel 8 for information and instructions relating to courses and/or starting times. The course and a verbal countdown may, at the start of any race, be transmitted on VHF Channel 8, at the race officer's sole discretion. The non-reception of any message by any boat shall not be grounds for redress.
- 9. PRIZES**
- 9.1 Place prizes will be awarded for the overall series.
- 9.2 Prizes will be presented at a time and date to be determined.
- 10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**
- Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. Neither the sponsors, the organising authority, nor any of its officers, employees, agents or assistants, will accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, or prior to, during, or after, the event.
- 11. INSURANCE**
- Each participating boat shall, for the duration of the event, have in force a valid third party liability insurance cover, including racing, to a minimum of £2,000,000.
