



RYA SEA SURVIVAL & ISAF OFFSHORE SAFETY COURSE

The one-day Sea Survival course provides a practical understanding of how to use the safety equipment on board your boat, including a swimming pool session using lifejackets and a life raft, and experience of using safety flares.

The ISAF Offshore Safety course provides a good knowledge of the safety equipment and the seamanship techniques needed to survive at sea in heavy weather, as well as training in weather forecasting, fire fighting and man overboard recovery.

The Sea Survival course fulfils the requirements for professional skippers of small craft working within 60 miles of a safe haven, including Boatmasters.

The ISAF Offshore Safety certificate conforms with the eligibility requirements of section 6.01 of the ISAF Special Regulations for category 0, 1 and some category 2 offshore races. These regulations require a percentage of the crew to have taken personal survival training.
