



## **RYA YACHTMASTER SHOREBASED COURSE**

A comprehensive course covering advance navigation, meteorology and seamanship; it assumes you already have some knowledge up to Day skipper standard. It will give you all the theory needed for Coastal Skipper training afloat and is a step towards a Yachtmaster Coastal or Yachtmaster Offshore exam.

<b>Course type:</b>	THEORY
<b>Suggested minimum pre-course experience:</b>	Some practical experience and knowledge of seamanship and navigation
<b>Assumed knowledge:</b>	Day skipper theory
<b>Course content:</b>	Advance seamanship, navigation and meteorology
<b>Ability after course:</b>	The syllabus arms would-be skippers with enough knowledge to move toward the practical Yachtmaster courses.
<b>Minimum duration:</b>	40 hours and 3 exam papers Some exercises will be set to be completed outside of the above course hours.

This course will start on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> January and will run as 3 hour sessions on Monday and Thursday evenings through to mid-March.
